- ❖ Ribbons to 4th place in all classes.
- ❖ Ribbons presented to all riders in 8 years & under classes.

- RULES & REGULATIONS -

1. All Pony Club riders must present their cards at the Secretary's Office (located ringside) before riding.
2. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** – neither the Organising Committee of this competition or PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
3. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
4. All riders must wear complying helmets. Rider onus to have correct helmet. Spot checks may occur.
5. Gear Check – is required for all PC competitors prior to competing.
6. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-laws.
7. Dogs and alcohol are prohibited – without exception.
8. Ridden horses must be at least 4 years of age. No stallions, colts or rigs.
9. This event will comply with the PCV EI & Biosecurity Guidelines that are current at the time of the event.
10. Medical Armbands are optional.
11. The Organising Committee reserve the right to cancel any classes, divide any class, alter times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
12. Age of riders is from the date of the Show.
13. PCV Lunging Policy applies.
14. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
15. Best Performed Off The Track Thoroughbred – highest point winner.
16. Handler Classes – handler's ability to control the horse is judged. Horse's conformation not to be taken into account.
17. Ridden Classes – to be judged on horse's manners and paces during a given workout.
18. Mount Most Suited – horses will be required to jump with the objective being to assess horse's suitability for showjumping/horse trials.
19. The Judge's decision is final.
20. Snaffle bridles only.
21. **COVID safe practices will be enforced for this event. Event Secretary will email all competitors closer to the competition with the current Covid-19 information, card check details etc.**
